

## Deadline extension for small business reopening, support

The application deadline for the Small Business Reopening and Support Grant has been extended to Friday, July 17<sup>th</sup>, to allow more time for businesses to apply.

The \$25 million program provides grants of up to \$5,000 to help eligible small businesses, non-profits, charities, and social enterprises to resume operations. It also includes a business continuity voucher of up to \$1,500 that can be used for advice and support to help them become more resilient in the coming months.

"As further restrictions are lifted, more and more small businesses are reopening and adapting to the new reality," said Geoff MacLellan, minister of Business.

"For many, the costs associated with reopening safely are an added pressure during an already stressful time. This is why we are extending the application deadline for businesses to apply for the Reopening and Support Grant."

The program is open to businesses that were ordered to close or greatly reduce their operations by the Public Health Order, or who were significantly impacted by social distancing and orders to stay home.

Eligible businesses must have been established before March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020, and experienced a year-over-year revenue decline of at least 30 per cent from either April 2019 to April 2020 or May 2019 to May 2020.

### Mabou Farmers' Market

Supporting local farmers and crafters is one of the best things you can do to help our economy rebound and at the same time, secure the very best food for your family and creative, unique goods for yourself or to gift to those you love. Gift certificates and tokens, redeemable for market merchandise, can be purchased by the entrance door in \$5 and \$25 denominations, and can be purchased with credit and/or debit cards if you prefer to use them over cash. The Mabou Farmers' Market opened their doors to shoppers last week with 20 vendors and will have even more vendors returning this week, so come on by and meet them.

One popular food producer is Peter, who opened the Buschmann Free Range Bio Farm in Cleveland, Cape Breton, upon his arrival from Germany in 2005. The "Bio" in his business name refers to the tradition of treating his farm animals in a responsible and natural way, raising them free of hormones, to produce the highest quality food products. Peter and his partner Leslee raise Berkshire, Duroc, and other pig breeds and heritage breed chickens. All meat processing is done in their own fully licensed facility, certified and inspected by the provincial food inspector, which ensures the quality of the meat and eggs they sell only in our region are always fresh and safe.

Their primary business is pork and sausages – producing over a dozen types of sausages – all gluten free, pre-cooked, and vacuum packed, made only with pure meat, without any filler or preservatives. Smoked sausages are smoked with cherry, maple, or apple wood. All you need do is just brown or BBQ them!

They also sell free-range eggs, cold cuts, bacon, Bavarian meatloaf (leberkaese), pork and pork jerky, smoked pepper sticks and schnitzel. All delicious and all of the highest quality!

The market has several fabric artists, including Josie of Josephine Clarke Textiles. Originally from Canada's west coast, she moved out to Cape Breton soon after graduating with a Bachelor's degree in Apparel Design, as the artist in residence for a design house in Port Hawkesbury. She says "Cape Breton gave me a life that at one point was a far-off dream for me."

Starting her business in 2018 was the culmination of sewing all her life, inspired by the everyday acts of creativity she saw in her rural upbringing, as she grew up around people who sewed, gardened, did woodwork, made fishing lures, and other useful things. Josephine makes an array of products from wall art, scarves, kimonos, bags and pouches, hair accessories, and even pain relief products – heating pads that are lavender infused and a perfect size to take with you in the car or while travelling.

This year, she is particularly proud of the "how-to" kits she sold online. She was teaching classes before COVID hit, and when people were stuck indoors, they really did want to do something positive and constructive, so the kits ended up being an un-expected success. And of course, she made masks! Lots of masks because we all need them!

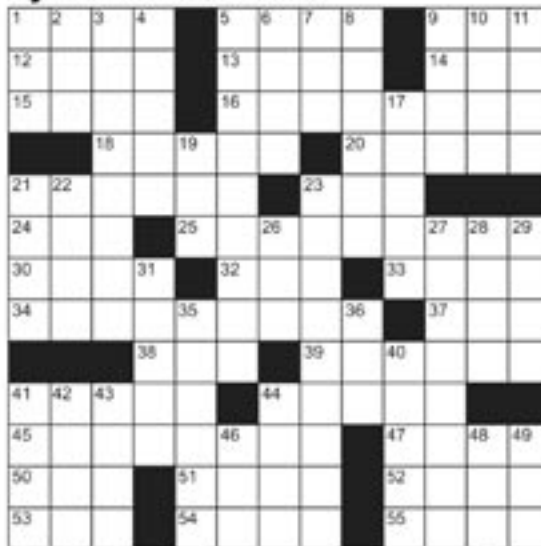
